Today, raising the level of human resources in the country to a high level of quality is an urgent issue. Half of the population of Uzbekistan are women, and about 17 million women live in our country.

During the years of independence, our Constitution and many laws and regulations have enabled women to protect their health, ensure their health, realize their potential in the socio-economic and political spheres, and take an active part in the life of an active citizen.

Today, with special emphasis on the place and role of women in society, organizational and legal mechanisms are being radically reformed to provide comprehensive social support to women, protect their rights and interests, and act as equal active citizens in society. work is underway.

In addition, all adopted legislation aimed at protecting the rights and interests of women in our country is based on international legal norms. The Republic of Uzbekistan has acceded to the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW), the International Convention on the Protection of Women's Political Rights and the Protection of Motherhood.

In the Address of the President to the Oliy Majlis on December 29, 2020, it was noted that further strengthening the role and status of women in public administration is one of the priorities of the ongoing reforms in our country. In this regard, special attention was paid to the fact that measures aimed at comprehensive support for women will continue in 2021.

It is known that in order to provide social support to the population in our country, a list of families in need of financial assistance and support, ie "Iron Book" was compiled. After the video conference of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on October 8, 2020 "On measures to increase the role of women and youth in society and employment", the new system A system of support and protection, targeted assistance to them has been introduced. For the first time, a "Women's Book" was introduced to systematically address women's issues and provide them with social support.

It is no coincidence that the issue of comprehensive support for women in need has risen to the state level. It should be noted that most of the main problems in society are the result of insufficient attention and respect for women. When a woman is abused, an unhealthy spiritual environment is formed in the family, she commits a crime, if a woman is ill, the nation's gene pool is destroyed, if a woman stays away from science and enlightenment, children grow up without upbringing. As a result, society is slowly declining.

By maintaining the Women's Book, an innovative socio-pedagogical healthy and stable environment will be created in families and neighborhoods, which is necessary for the spiritual development of women.

At the same time, a "Women's Book" was formed in each mahalla, district, city and region. These lists are separate from the Iron Book, which includes unemployed women over the age of 30 who have the need and desire for social, legal, psychological support, knowledge and vocational training. As a result, systematic, targeted work has been established with them.

It should also be noted that in order to increase the effectiveness of this work, on January 8, 2021, the Cabinet of Ministers adopted a resolution "On additional measures for social support of women." In

accordance with this Resolution, the Interim Procedure for the systematic solution of women's problems through the maintenance of the "Women's Book" and their social support was approved.

In the regions, the task of identifying women in need of social protection over the age of 30 in 9 categories has been set in the mahallas.

A number of scientific researches are being carried out in our society to increase the political activity of women and provide them with comprehensive social support. Also, the sector responsible for maintaining the new system of studying and solving the problems of women and youth through the community system, 9 categories of women and the "Women's Book" included in the "Women's Book" in the framework of a research project on the role of the "Women's Notebook" in society Public opinion polls were conducted for working groups, citizens' assemblies and staff, as well as activists, responsible organizations, and members of the Women's Advisory Board.

The public survey was based on the conceptual ideas, theoretical and pedagogical foundations of the mechanisms of formation of the "Women's Notebook".

The knowledge of the role of women in the upbringing of children and the rich national educational heritage included in the "Women's Book" will be formed, and their national values will be passed down from generation to generation through their study, preservation, promotion and teaching. Women's confidence in the future will increase as they find their place in life.
