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"THE USE OF ICT IN THE TEACHING OF ENGLISH IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS"

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Annotation:

Therefore, it requires a different approach to the process of educating the younger generation. The role of the teacher in the classroom is also changing. The teacher is now mainly a facilitator. It is time for teachers who want to keep pace with the times to be ready to bring any part of the lesson to life through ICT. The introduction of information and communication technologies in the educational process is becoming increasingly important, especially in the teaching and learning of foreign languages. New information technologies offer great opportunities for teaching foreign languages, play an important role in obtaining quality knowledge in science and increase the effectiveness of education. It is well known that in accordance with the requirements of the time, no lessons in this subject should be given without the presentation of the teacher or students.

From the 2013–2014 academic year, foreign languages from the first grades of general secondary schools will be taught first in the form of games and then as a basic subject using ICT tools. In accordance with this important decision, today, in particular, foreign language lessons have been considered in more depth. In order to properly defend the country's honor on the world stage, our young people must first be able to compete with their foreign peers. Today, the competition is in foreign languages, especially English, which is an international business language. ICT tools are computer technology, tape recorders, books, video equipment, electronic whiteboards that allow you to save time and learn more and more effectively. Several didactic issues can be addressed through the use of ICT and, in particular, the Internet in foreign language classes. Of these, when testing students' knowledge:

various online tests;

off-line tests, ie the use of electronic versions of tests;

There are many tests on the Internet for students from elementary to advanced level, such as TOEFL and IELTS.

The advantage of such tests for the student is an objective and quick response. Simultaneous testing of students with different levels of knowledge in explaining a new topic: improving the quality of lessons through photos, clips, movies, videos, for example: students not only get simple information about different foreign countries from the text of the book, but also virtual tours, videos, spoons, clips about the traditions and customs of foreign countries.

To reinforce the topic:

students create projects;

search for additional information in interdisciplinary classes;

Significantly increases students' interest in learning by preparing presentations or chatting with foreign friends via email.

When using ICT in teaching, the teacher should plan and prepare for it in accordance with state standards. In the classroom, ICT can never take the place of the teacher, but rather help him. Depending on the content of the lesson, ICT and other pedagogical technologies should be used wisely in turn. The purpose of introducing ICT into the teaching process is to enrich the lesson, to provide information that can not be given by ordinary books, didactic exhibitions. In short, the use of innovative methods in English lessons develops students' logical thinking skills, fluency, and the ability to respond quickly and accurately.
