- 2- In the year 2022-23, it has been observed that 108 students participated in the district-level Football championship whereas 57 were the medalists, and 43 students participated in the regional level Football championship whereas 26 were the medalists. 12 students participated at the state level whereas there were no medalists. In that year no students participated in the national level Football championship.
- 3-In the year 2023-24, it has been observed that 114 students participated in the district-level Football championship whereas 66 were the medalists. 54 students participated in the regional level Football championship whereas 34 were the medalists. 15 students participated at the state level whereas there were no medalists. In that year no students participated in the national-level Football championship.
- 4- In the year 2021-22, a study shows that 87 students participated in the district-level Kabaddi championship whereas 56 were the medalists. 55 students participated in the regional level Kabaddi championship whereas 21 were the medalists. 5 students participated at the state level whereas there were no medalists. In that year no students participated in the national level Kabaddi championship.
- 5- In the year 2022-23, a study shows that 191 students participated in the district-level Kabaddi championship whereas 125 were the medalists. 62 students participated in the regional level Kabaddi championship whereas 27 were the medalists. 17 students participated at the state level whereas 3 were medalists. Only 1 student participated in the national-level Kabaddi championship.

- 6- In the year 2023-24, a study shows that 188 students participated in the district-level Kabaddi championship whereas 100 were the medalists. 67 students participated at the regional level whereas 31 were the medalists. 13 students participated at the state level whereas there were no medalists. In that year no student participated in the national-level Kabaddi championship.
- 7- In the year 2021-22, it has been concluded that, 90 students participated in District level Kho-Kho championship whereas 39 were the medalists. 17 students participated in regional level Kho-Kho whereas 5 were the medalists. In that year no students have participated in state level and national level Kho-Kho championship.
- 8- In the year 2022-23, it has been concluded that, 125 students participated in District level Kho-Kho championship whereas 58 were the medalists. 29 students participated in regional level Kho-Kho whereas 9 were the medalists. 5 students have participated in state level whereas there were no medalists. In that year no students participated in national level Kho-Kho championship.
- 9- In the year 2023-24, it has been concluded that, 133 students participated in District level Kho-Kho championship whereas 69 were the medalists. 39 students participated in regional level Kho-Kho whereas 14 were the medalists. 5 students have participated in state level whereas there were no medalists. In that year no students participated in national level Kho-Kho championship.

Conclusion

The analysis of sports achievements over the academic years 2021-22, 2022-23, and 2023-24 reveals a gradual increase in participation and success at the district and regional levels across various sports disciplines. There was a marked improvement in the number of students participating in football, kabaddi, kho-kho. Notably, participation and medal tallies at the district level had consistently improved, reflecting the growing engagement and performance of students in competitive sports. However, the performance at state and national levels remains limited, with very few students advancing beyond regional competitions, and even fewer attaining medals at higher levels.
